CANCELLATION POLICY FOR ALL CONFERENCE REGISTRATION FEES

By registering for the ABANA Conference, you accept this cancellation policy and agree to be bound by its terms.

Notification of cancellations for refunds must be submitted in writing to the ABANA Central Office postmarked or e-mailed by May 15, 2010. No cancellations will be accepted via phone. A cancellation fee equal to 40% of all conference registration fees will be charged for cancellations made on or after April 1, 2010. There will be no refunds for cancellations on or after May 15, 2010. Membership dues are not refundable.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK REQUIRED
